

Local Rules

The rules of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the following local rules govern all play:

- **1.** Stones in bunkers, "Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)";
- 2. Immovable obstructions Rule (24-2) Relief may be taken from; (a) water irrigation equipment (all sprinkler heads and control satellites) (b) buggy paths and service roads (c) stone constructions outside a hazard, including retaining walls and boundary walls (d) young trees which have been tagged or staked with blue coloring;
- **3.** Out of bounds (Rule 27 applies) (a) beyond boundary fences (b) beyond white posts outlining out of bounds (c) in the car park to the right of the 9th hole;
- **4.** Course conditions (a) embedded balls (b) need to clean ball, lift clean and wipe (c) preferred lies/winter rules (d) aeration holes. Relief will be available at certain times of the year and notice will be given at Reception and on the member's notice board;
- **5.** Greenkeepers work is considered ground under repair. Relief without penalty may be taken in accordance with Rule 25;

Etiquette

- No player may start a round without registering at Reception;
- **2.** Golf shoes with soft spikes must be worn. The Starter will check this;
- **3.** The Club dress code must be adhered to. The Starter will not allow players to commence play if any part of the code is ignored;
- **4.** If any group loses more than one hole on the group in front they must call the following group through. Failure to do so in competitions will incur penalties;
- **5.** The Marshalls may instruct players to quicken their pace of play or allow a group through; any requests ignored may result in the players being asked to leave the course.

100, 150 and 200 metre distance markers are measured to the centre of green.
